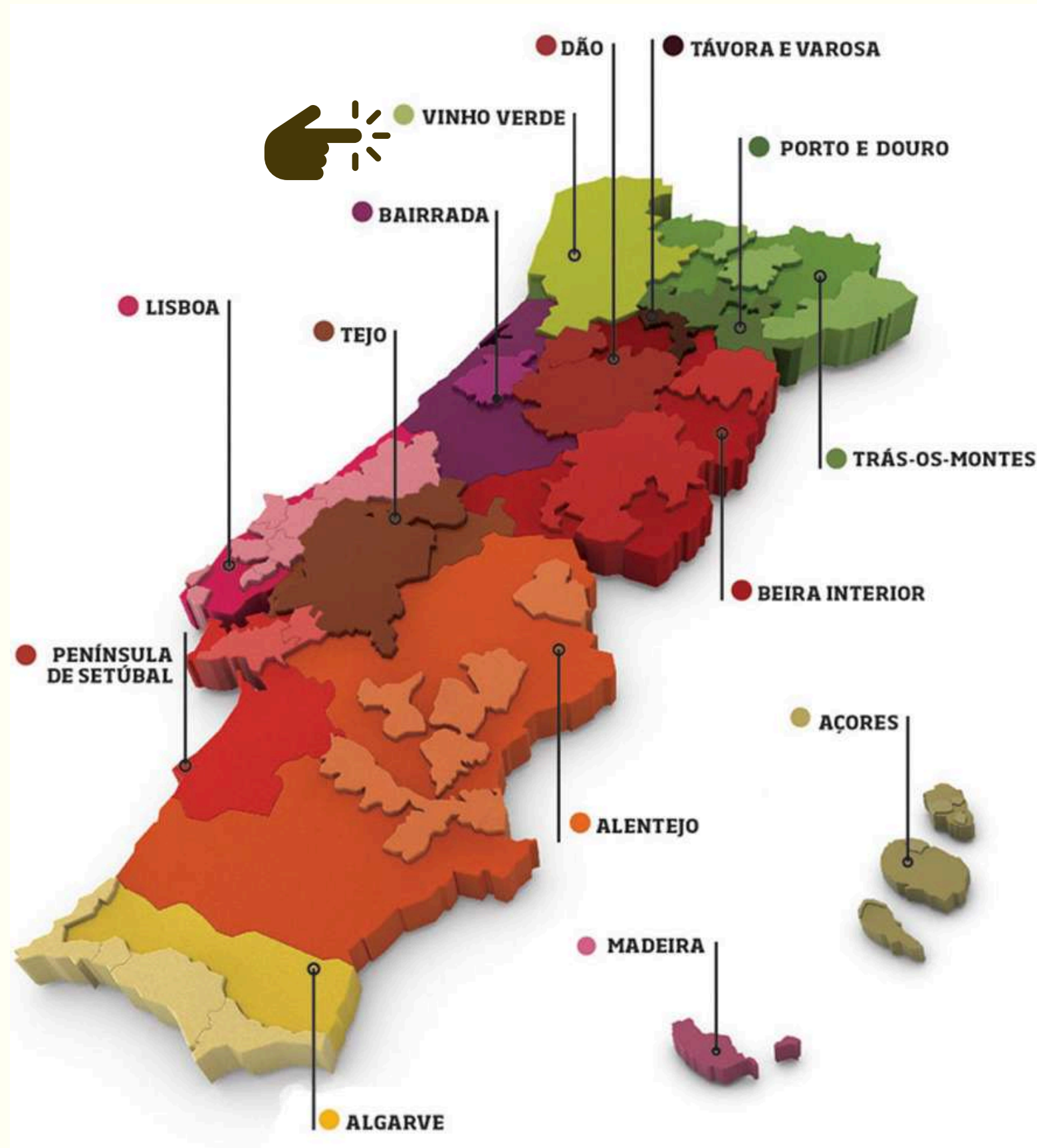

OUR HISTORY



Quinta da Raza history goes back to the **XVIII Century** and it has remained in the **same family ever since.**

Since 1987, **Diogo Teixeira Coelho** has continued the family tradition joining forces with his wife, **Mafalda**, dedicating their lives to Quinta da Raza.



OUR HISTORY

The origins of Quinta da Raza can be found in a famous manor house in Veade, Celorico de Basto, known as "A Casa do Outeiro", of medieval origin, declared a Property of Public Interest in 1977.

Vineyards and wine have always been the family's main agricultural activity, due to the quality of the grapes produced.

A good example of this is the Medal of Agricultural Merit awarded to the great-great-grandfather of the current owner, Diogo, on 27 November 1863, in a public ceremony presided over by the Portuguese royal family, King Luís I.



OUR HISTORY

The current family's ownership of the estate known as Raza - so called because it is a considerably flat area, but the surroundings are quite hilly and mountainous - has been documented since 1769, although the actual ownership of the land dates back to earlier times.



TRADITION VS. INNOVATION

Despite the use of **modern technology** related to oenology, the **traditional techniques** of wine producing are still **preserved**.

Quinta da Raza has a great focus on innovation by **bringing back to life autochthonous grapes** and exploring modern techniques of wine production.

PORTFOLIO NAT

These wines reflect a **minimal intervention approach, letting nature dictate the fermentation with wild yeasts.** In the case of the **Pet Nats white and rose**, the spontaneous fermentation ends in the bottle, creating a fine bubble.

In the case of the **Raza Curtimenta and Raza Lagares**, the grapes are fermented in centuries-old garnite “lagares” using the traditional method of foot-treading.

The **insects on the labels are known for their efficiency in biological pest control.** It is meant to represent our holistic approach to viticulture and sustainability.

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

1º Vinho Verde is not the name of the wine but of the DOC (Denomination of Controlled Origin) Region which was demarcated in 1908 and is one of the largest in Europe.

2º The Vinho Verde Region does not solely produce white wine. We also offer Rose, Red and Sparkling wines of quality

3º Despite the common knowledge that Vinho Verde wines do not have ageing potential, this is false specially for wines produced with grape varieties such as Alvarinho and Avesso.
