HARVEST 2022

Annata calda! Hot and dry has been the theme for this 2022 vintage. A very early harvest starting a week earlier (August 26th) compared to last year's for Collosorbo (South, argile, 220m). This vintage also broke the rules as we usually finish our harvest campaign with Pian Bossolino (South East, 360m, argile upper; calcareous/ galestro lower part), but instead, we finished with Giardinello (South West, mix calcareous & sand 320m).

Let's also give a warm welcome to our "rookie vineyard" who entered the cellar for the first time: new acquisition Osteriaccia (south west, argile calcareous 310m).

All our Sangiovese were in the Cantina by September 20th. as a reminder, 2021 we finished October 2nd.



2022 100% ORGANIC BRUNELLO

As you know by now, Natalie has done a tremendous work in the vineyard since 2012. 2019 was the first vintage with wines from organic vineyard. As of this year, the 2018 built cantina is now working under organic certification and Brunello 2022 will be organic certified.
