

## 10 Windisch Niersteiner Auflangen Riesling Spatlese 2012

*"Riesling is a light-skinned, aromatic grape of German origin which is – if the majority of top wine critics are to be believed – the world's finest white-wine grape variety. These old vineyards in Nierstein with its deep red soil retains the heat, and its wines often show exotic fruit flavors and are known for their freshness. These grapes are hand-picked, then de-stemmed and gently pressed, which makes Windisch-Wines the most enjoyable to the fanatical Riesling fans."*

**Drink-Recommendation:** seafood, salt-water fish, veal- pork- or lamb-roasts, rich mild cheese.
