With the 2016 vintage of Old Patch Red, we are introducing an entirely new package that dramatically reflects the wine's composition. OPR references our "Old Patch" sourcing from our winery's historical roots when pre-Prohibition vines were sourced. Today, that is a combination of individual "patches" or grape lots that we now blend to create a harmonious wine. Each detail on the label has significance including the grid background representing the individual lots, the red triangle that connects to our

Harvest began with yet another early bud break. Our Old Vine block 601 Sangiovese was the first one to awaken on February 20th. Bud break was three weeks earlier than typical and harvest started record-early as well.

The growing conditions were excellent for the rest of the season, with the exception of a week or two of a mini heatwave.

The 2016 OPR Old Patch Red is predominately Zinfandel, blended with Petite Sirah, Carignane, and Syrah, resulting in a very fruity yet complex and full-bodied Rhone-style wine. The wine is dark red in color with intense black cherry aromas, blueberries, and cherry cola as an immediate impression.

With aeration, nuances of ripe plums, vanilla, and cocoa are showing with a slight dose of oak and toast. On the mouth the wine is fresh and juicy, with youthful brightness, finishing long and fruity.
