## 1990 Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence Rosé

Founded by the Knights Templar in the 13th Century, ownership of the estate has changed numerous times over the years. In 2006, the estate was sold to Christian and Marina Garin, who were old friends of the previous owners and themselves from local Provencal families. Since the sale, this iconic estate has gone from strength to strength, with the Garins completing a conversion to organic farming (Agriculture Biologique) in 2018.
