STYLE & TYPE: Rosé & Still

VARIETIES: Niellucciu

VITICULTURE: 42.2 acres Niellucciu. Combination of mechanical and manual harvests. Average 55 hectoliters/hectare yields.

SOIL: Rocky-clay mixture (argilo-caillouteux).

RATINGS & REVIEWS: 88 WINE ENTHUSIAST

VINIFICATION: Total destemming. Temperature-controlled cuvaion of approximately three weeks. Selected yeast from Corsica Institute used for the whites and rosés. Fermentation for all wines takes place in temp-controlled stainless steel tanks. The rosés are produced entirely from direct press juice. No malolactic fermentation for whites and rosés. All wines bottled with light plaque filtration.
