



TECHNICAL NOTES

DOMAINE DE LANCYRE 2015 ROUSSANNE

Purchased in 1970 by the Durand and Valentin families, the Château was originally built in the 1500's, on the ruins of a 12th century fort. Records of winemaking date back to 1550! Lancyre is now viewed among the top estates of Pic Saint-Loup, which has justifiably garnered a reputation as the Languedoc's single best wine district.

VINEYARDS

About 192 acres total (135 acres of AOC vineyards) planted to Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Roussanne, Marsanne, Rolle & Viognier.

APPELLATION

IGP Val de Montferrand Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert.

COMPOSITION

85% Roussanne (with equal parts Viognier and Marsanne).

VITICULTURE

Yields of 3 tons/acre. Clay/limestone based soils.

Lancyre's white varietals are planted in the coolest, northern parts of Pic Saint-Loup.

VINIFICATION

Racked then fermented at 64 -68°F, after a delicate pressing. Stainless steel vinification. 4 months on the lees, with regular battonage. Unoaked.

ALCOHOL

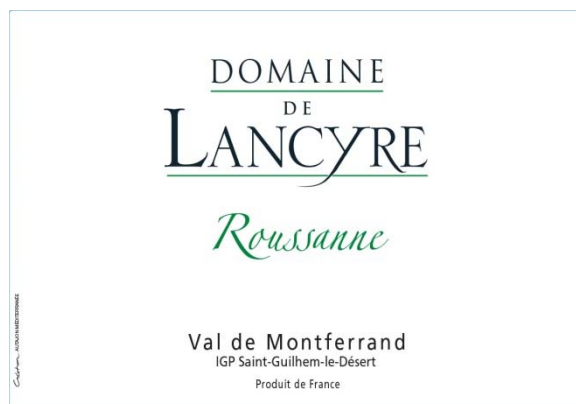

Aromas of peaches and country hay on the nose, with just a touch of spearmint and honey. Big, bold and crisp, with great freshness on the palate.

SERVE WITH

Enjoy this distinctive, unoaked white on its own, or with poultry, creamy pasta dishes, or seafood (especially sole or fried calamari).
