Landmark Overlook Chardonnay 2015

“From its canary-yellow hue to its nose of honey-butter, chamomile and melon, this is truly a “landmark” vintage for this wine.

Forty-two individual lots were sourced from 24 vineyards throughout Sonoma County, aged for ten months in French oak (25% new) and fermented with native yeast for complexity. 2015 was the winery’s earliest harvest in its 25-year history. On the palate, the graceful herbal notes of lemon verbena are soft and floral, with honey-nutty notes of lanolin alongside. Texturally creamy, with a cookie-batter quality, the wine is round and opulent with a toasty finish.”
