Le Cadeau Vineyard wines are crafted from 100% estate-grown Pinot Noir & Chardonnay in the Chehalem Mountains AVA. Each small production cuvee is selected to represent the various clonal plantings, aspect, sunlight, and soil changes found throughout our 18 planted acres.

2018 “Côte Est” Pinot Noir



The Côte Est cuvee is sourced from three Eastern-facing blocks of our estate, receiving less sunlight exposure than anywhere else on the vineyard. The naturally cooler temperature and Nekia soils (part of the Jory family) provide a layered complexity, darker-fruit character, and naturally bright acidity.

“Spice-accented red berry and baking spice aromas, along with suggestions of musky saffras and licorice. Penetrating on the palate, offering dark raspberry and cherry flavors and a subtle, refreshingly bitter touch of blood orange. Dusty tannins come in slowly and fold smoothly into the wine’s energetic fruit on the insistent, focused finish.” -*Vinous, 92 Points*
