Le Cadeau Vineyard wines are crafted from 100% estate-grown Pinot Noir & Chardonnay in the Chehalem Mountains AVA. Each small production cuvee is selected to represent the various clonal plantings, aspect, sunlight, and soil changes found throughout our 18 planted acres.

2019 “Rocheux” Pinot Noir



The Rocheux cuvee is sourced from the rockiest portion of our estate vineyard – the Western slope, an area high in content of broken volcanic basalt. Warm evenings and cool nights provide balance, resulting in depth with crisp acidity, and an underlying mineral structure characteristic of Le Cadeau Vineyard.

“Mineral-accented raspberry and cherry aromas are complemented by building floral, baking spice and cola nuances. Juicy and tightly wound on entry, offering cherry and red fruit flavors that deepen through the back half.
