Pinot Noir 'Sophie Bertin'

WINERY OVERVIEW

This cuvée was born from the meeting of Eric Louis, Sancerre wine-grower and wine-merchant, and Sophie Bertin, a woman deeply rooted in the Sancerre region. Sophie means wisdom in Greek, and Sophie shared not only her wisdom but also challenged Eric in their winemaking. "Dare I not?" Sophie often asked, and Eric would reply, "Challenge accepted!" Together they created a more feminine cuvée with suppleness, subtlety and great elegance. Sophie's wine was born!

VINEYARD

Clay-limestone soils.

VITICULTURE

Harvested from the slopes of the Loire Valley near Sancerre. Grapes are destemmed and inspected to remove any stems or any spoiled berries.

VINIFICATION

The grapes were conveyed to stainless steel tanks for a cold skin maceration. The vatting time is short to maximize the fruit and obtain an easy-drinking wine. The juice then undergoes alcoholic fermentation for 2-3 weeks at a controlled temperature of 18°C to 25°C. After devatting, the pressed juice and free-run juice are blended.

AGING

Wine rest in stainless steel time until bottling in the springtime.
