WINERY OVERVIEW

Made by Boutinot which encompasses vineyards and cellars in France, Italy and South Africa as well as long standing relationships with hundreds of winegrowers throughout the world. Wines are crafted by both vinifying fruit from Boutinot's own vineyards and by selecting and blending wine from partner growers. Boutinot's dedicated Product Managers (including two Masters of Wine) work hand in hand with experienced and highly talented winemakers and blenders to bring their winemaking philosophy to life. It's their job to ensure all 'Made by Boutinot' wines are crafted to match stylistic ideals of how wine should taste and deliver Boutinot's vision of high quality wines at every price point.

VINEYARD

Vines are managed using lutte raisonnée.

TERROIR

Soil is a combination of limestone, sand and sea shale.

VITICULTURE

Domaine de Vedilhan (pronounced 'Domaine de Ved-ee-ohn') is the estate of the Fayet family based in the village of Moussan close to Narbonne. The property is quite unique in that there is a natural brook running around the outskirts which provides natural irrigation to give much needed water. This gives the wines their freshness and appeal; keeping the vines cool in a very hot climate. 50% of the production from this Domaine is used for Boutinot wines.

VINIFICATION

The wine is fermented in 2/3 mature French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Richly textured with bitter-sweet aromas of crystalized orange peel, ginger and cream. Barrel fermentation brings subtle texture and richness rather than a dominant oaky flavor, leaving rich stone fruits to shine through.
