Dominio De Eguren - Vino de la Tierra de Castilla



Location & Vineyard	Non denomination vineyards in Manchuela, Spain. Multiple vineyards managed by Dominio de Eguren in Manchuela, Spain.
Year(s) Planted	Between 1946 and 1986.
Variety	100% Tempranillo
Viticulture	Dominio de Eguren manages and controls multiple vineyards in Manchuela Spain. The Eguren family sets themselves apart compared to other Vino de la Tierra wines by selecting vineyards with advanced age and low yields, and performing a rigorous selection of the grapes.
Yields	2.3 tons per acre
Vineyard Area	111 acres.
Altitude	2,000 ft.
Soils	Poor calcareous clay soils with a high proportion of limestone. The surface is spotted with pebbles, resulting in good surface drainage.
Climate & Harvest	Continental climate with a Mediterranean influence. Beginning of October.
Winemaking	Cold maceration followed by a six-day fermentation with two pump-over' s daily. Controlled micro-oxygenation during the fermentation. Eight-day post fermentative maceration.
Production	Cold stabilized and filtered before bottling. 10,000 cases.

Comments

A more complex and nuanced wine from Dominio de Eguren that is the result of a more rigorous selection of grapes from lower yielding vineyards followed by a light ageing process. Mature fruit intermixed with spices and toasted coffee.
