

RRP 2017 ROCK ISLAND CABERNET SAUVIGNON COLUMBIA VALLEY

AVA: Columbia Valley

SUB AVAs + VINEYARDS: Columbia Valley – Conner Lee Wahluke Slope – Ravenscliff, Sundance, Clifton Snipes Mountain – Newhouse Yakima Valley – Den Hoed

WINEMAKING NOTES: The grapes were selected from several vineyards across the Columbia Valley, providing a range of different which create greater nuance and complexity when blended together.

TASTING NOTES

AROMA: Initial hit of vanilla and toasted oak spice, gives way to deep, dark black fruit like black currants, plum, and blackberry jam.

FLAVOR: Rich, concentrated mouthfeel on the midpalate leads to a long, lingering spicy black pepper finish.

VARIETAL(S): 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, and 11% Syrah

DATE OF HARVEST: September 23, 2017 – October 21, 2017

BOTTLED: May 2020

ALCOHOL: 13.5% TA(gal/L): 5.9 VA(gal/L): 0.63 pH: 3.68

AGING: Aged 30 months in 20% new American oak barrels.
