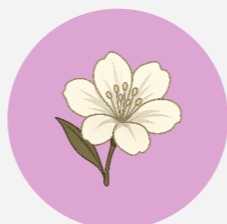
The estate

Domaine de Vauroux was created in 1956 by Tricon's family. Olivier's father, Jean-Pierre and his uncle, Claude, planted their first vines in 1972. They subsequently acquired multiple plots, creating an estate of 13 hectares in one contiguous area. From then on, the family farm, located on the hills of Chablis, was almost exclusively dedicated to working the vines. In 1998, Olivier acquired the Domaine de Vauroux, and began to expand the estate, now he owns 50 hectares of vines and 200 hectares of cereals and hazelnut trees.

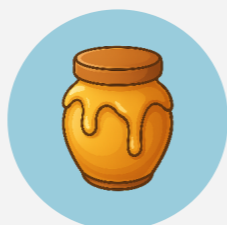

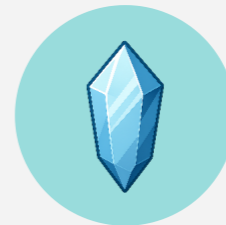
