The cherished Napa Valley landscape is planted to 47,000 acres of wine grapes and segmented into 16 district AVA's, each lauded for their unique and diverse terroir. Ranging from cool, coastal influences to warmer temperatures, mountainous terrain to valley floor, clay soil to volcanic rock, the Napa Valley American Viticulture Areas are truly remarkable.

1881 NAPA was created in one of the Napa Valley's oldest historical Victorian homes with a mission to celebrate the origins of America's premier winemaking region and the pioneers that founded it. The wines of 1881 Napa honor the rich history, legacy and heritage of this world-famous winegrowing region.



About the Vintage:

The 2023 Napa Valley growing season was marked by an unusually cool, wet start with late bud break and one of the longest hang times in recent memory, resulting in a delayed but extended harvest into mid-November. Mild, consistent weather and abundant winter rains supported steady ripening, producing grapes with fresh acidity, deep color and elegant phenolic development that many winemakers are calling an exceptional, age-worthy vintage.

Winemaker's Notes:

This Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from vineyards spanning the picturesque landscapes of Napa Valley, where the warmth of hillside vineyards and the richness of valley floor fruit converge to craft a wine that celebrates the region's varied terroir. Aromas elegantly rise from the glass, revealing notes of lively red and black currants, delicate hints of leather, cedar, and spice, lending the wine an enchanting earthy charm. The palate unfolds with a burst of flavors, dominated by juicy blackberry and currant, accompanied by a subtle layer of indulgent brown sugar. The lingering finish is both prolonged and silky, balanced by luxurious, smooth tannins.
