#### WINERY OVERVIEW

Domaine Durand is a family estate where 3 generations of passionate winegrowers work together, allying experience, tradition, and modernity. #### VINEYARD

82 acres in the hamlet of "Les Epsailles" (commune of Crézancy, in eastern part of Sancerre appellation).

#### TERROIR

Soils are dominated by Terres Blanches (Kimmeridgian marls) and Caillotes (stony, calcareous soils).

#### VITICULTURE

Average age of the vines: 30 years. Sustainably grown.

#### VINIFICATION

10-15 days fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

#### AGING

Matured for 3 months on the fine lees prior to bottling.

#### TASTING NOTES

Vibrant, lemon color. Aromas of citrus fruit and white flowers on the nose, with a classic backdrop of minerality. Medium-bodied on the palate, with concentrated fruit and great energy and verve. A classic, well-balanced Sancerre Blanc with a long, clean finish.
