

### PETITE GRAPPES 2021

*A partnership between vigneron Sebastien Calduch and Jeff Carrel whose mission is to preserve the art and tradition of winemaking in harmony with nature. Located at the very end of Occitania, high in the Pyrenees mountains, Domaine D'Ansignan delivers estate grown wines with energy and balance. On the oldest vines of the estate, the "petites grappes" are the smallest bunches of grapes harvested young for the most juice and freshness possible.*

#### VINEYARDS

18 hectares in the foothills of the Pyrenees. From La Garrigue plot with old vines average 50+ years, the oldest 100+ years old. Slopes widening from 164-328 ft from West to East, over a length of 1969 ft high. Exposed SSE to SSW. Altitudes between 623 to 689 ft with slopes between 4-10%. Granitic and clay soil.

#### APPELLATION

AOC Côtes du Roussillon

#### COMPOSITION

50% Grenache, 50% Carignan

#### VITICULTURE

Sustainably farmed, in transition to Certified Organic. Dry-farmed vineyards. Pruned in Goblet form. Harvested by hand.

#### WINEMAKING

Vinified separately. Partial whole cluster fermentation with native yeasts. Pressed and combined for malolactic fermentation. Unfined. Aged in concrete tanks.

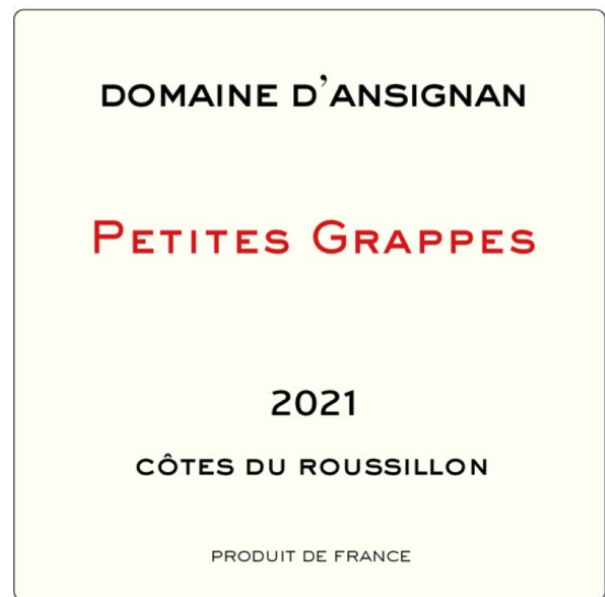
