BARBARESCO DOCG 2021

100% Nebbiolo grapes



Barbaresco is our flagship wine.

Produced from a selection of the best grapes grown in the villages of Barbaresco and Neive. It's a blend of three vineyards: Fausoni, facing east in Neive village, Bernino, facing east in Barbaresco and Ovello, facing west in Barbaresco village. Each vineyard is fermented and aged on its own and blended together few months before bottling. Barbaresco and Langhe appellations are all about soil and vineyard's exposition. The soil in the Barbaresco area is on average 50% silt, 50% clay and limestone in percentages that vary depending on the location.

East is exposed to the sun until 3pm and it's where the most flowery and red fruit aromas come from while west is exposed to sun during afternoon and release more bold wines with ripe aromas.

Spontaneous fermentation of 4-5 weeks with submerged cap in stainless tank, aged 14 months in large barrels of 2.000 litres.

Once tasted you find dry red flowers, ripe raspberries and blueberries. The sip is full body, elegant with fine tannins for a long finishing.

Be sure to enjoy the wine revealing in the glass.
