HISTORIC:

Founded in 1857, the Tailhan house quickly became noticed and rewarded at many Universal Wine Exhibitions. After the passing of Auguste and his sons during the First World War his wife continued the legacy of the house adding “Veuve” to the name which translate to “Widow.”

GREAT VALUE:

Comparing Charmat wines currently available only 3 other brands can match the price, but not the quality!

VINIFICATION:

Charmat Method fermentation in a thermoregulated VAT at low temperatures. The wine has been aged for a minimum of 3 months with daily lees stirring.

VARIETALS:

Blend of Ugni Blanc and Colombard sourced from vineyards located in the Languedoc-Roussillon. Percentages may vary to maintain style.

TASTING NOTE:

An enticing bouquet of fresh white fruits with a fine, persistent finish. It unfolds with elegant notes of crisp apple and ripe pear, presenting a refreshing and well-balanced palate.

ABV: 11.5%

RS: < 10 g/L
