TOURIGA NACIONAL

Favonius is the name of the west wind in Roman mythology. In the Portuguese wine region of Lisboa, where we grow our grapes, the western wind is predominant and comes from the Atlantic Ocean, having a huge influence on the climate where we grow our grapes.

THE VINEYARD

The vineyard is located in Alcobaça, inside the Lisboa demarcated wine region, on chalky-clay soil. The harvest was done by hand and took place on the first week of September 2022.

THE VINIFICATION

The grapes of Touriga Nacional were destemmed and went through a pre-fermentation cold soaking for 10 days. After two days of a wild fermentation in stainless steel vats, the juice was drained and the fermentation continued without the skins. These were lightly pressed, and the resulting juice was blended to fill the stainless steel vat where the wine aged.
