GRAPES

Merlot 80% & Cabernet Franc 20%

SOIL

The Gravel, sand, and clay—typical of the Côtes-de-Bordeaux area, ensuring efficient drainage and good grape quality.

VINEYARD

Family-run estate in the Bordeaux vineyard. Not a classified growth, but practicing sustainable viticulture, respecting soil and vine balance.

WINEMAKING

Manual or mechanical harvesting, followed by vinification in stainless steel tanks. Maceration ensures good extraction of color, tannins, and aromas.

TASTING NOTES

Deep purple color with violet highlights. The nose reveals black fruit aromas (cassis, blackberry) with subtle floral notes (rose). Smooth attack, full and structured body with ripe tannins. Fruity and slightly spicy finish; some vintages display a candy-like red fruit profile.

FOOD AND WINE PAIRING

Pairs well with red meats (beef, lamb), stews, tagines, roasted poultry, and aged cheeses (tomme, Saint-Nectaire).

AGEING POTENTIAL

Best served at 16–18 °C. Enjoy young (2–4 years after harvest), though more structured vintages can age 5–7 years or more.
