History of Brewery

- Established in 1884 in Wakayama, family owned and operated for almost a century and a half
- The current company name Sekkai Itto (uniting the world through sake) was christened by Ohkuma Shigenobu, one of the founding fathers of modern-day Japan and the founder of Waseda University, one of Japan’s leading universities

Points of Differentiation:

- Carefully crafted Japanese sake as the base
- Arita is one of the top three prized Mikan (Mandarin Orange) producing regions of Japan
- Tree ripened Mandarin are crushed and blended with the base sake to make a refreshing drink

Tasting Comment

Aroma – freshly squeezed Mandarin Orange

Taste – ripe, juicy Mandarin Orange bursting with flavor

Finish – long and rich finish with refreshing acidity

Enjoy chilled, on the rocks, or as a spritzer.
