### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This year we experienced the best that Marlborough has to offer, with one of the lowest rainfall volumes recorded and warm, sunny days being the norm. This was followed by a perfectly timed switch to cooler nights in the weeks prior to harvest, allowing the grapes to finish ripening slowly. These conditions helped to create wines that will show off their lively fruit concentration, balanced by joyous acidity. The wines were gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel tanks.

### TASTING NOTES

Fresh and fragrant, the wine shows aromas of passionfruit, green apple, apricot, and lemon zest. The palate is equally appealing with excellent vibrancy and fruit intensity, finishing long and mouth-watering.
