## GRANXA VELLA

### Single Vineyard

Plot wine from old vineyards of "GRANXA VELLA".

"Vella" in Galician means "old", because to produce this wine we use the 50-60 year old vineyard located next to a small Romanesque church dating back to the 13th century.

On the banks of the river Cabe, the vineyards of that period (1960s-1970s) were characterised by the joint planting of Mencía, Garnacha tintorera, and other local varieties.

Vinification is carried out in 1000 litre open-top vats. Spontaneous fermentation, between 25 and 30 day maceration with gentle daily manual pumping over from the bottom to the top. Spontaneous malolactic fermentation and ageing in French oak barrels.
