## AS SAIÑAS

### Single Vineyard

From the AS SAIÑAS plot, which gives its name to the winery.

The resurgence of the historic vineyards of the river Cabe in this single-varietal Mencía.

Vineyard terraces recovered by the founder of the winery, Javier Fernández, on the slopes of the river Cabe. A highly valued area of traditional vineyards in the village of Espasantes that were abandoned due to emigration. This vineyard began its recovery in the early 90s. Today we continue with small projects to extend and recover the terraces.

Double selection of clusters, spontaneous fermentation in small stainless steel vats and in 1000 litre open-top casks with 45% of whole grapes.  
3 week maceration with gentle daily manual pumping over from the bottom to the top.  
Spontaneous malolactic fermentation and ageing in French oak barrels and stainless steel vats.
